Holiday Dangers for your Pets

Hazard	Who is	Commonly
	affected	Observed Signs
Chocolate	Cats, dogs	Vomiting, diarrhoea, tremors and seizures
Raisins	Dogs	Vomiting, diarrhoea, anorexia, lethargy and kidney failure
Antifreeze	Cats, dogs, other small mammals , horses	Vomiting, druken appearance, excessive drinking and urinating
Electrical Cords	Cats, dogs	Electrocution or
		shock
Human flu medication	Dogs,	May affect one
	cats, birds, small mammals	or more body system
Tiger Lilies	Cats	Vomiting, kidney damage and probable death
Mistletoe	Dogs, cats, birds	GIT upset, low blood pressure and collapse




Lumps and Bumps: Need we worry?

Lumps can of course be cancerous but not always and it's important to consider that many other things can be possibilities, eg: abscesses, infection, foreign material, cysts etc.

If they do appear to be cancerous they can be of two types:

- 1. Benign do not spread but may grow locally and can be a problem depending on the site, ie: armpit, thus affecting walking, or if they ulcerate or get caught.
- 2. Malignant more aggressive and have the potential to spread to other sites.



So what is the next step?

FNA: Take cells and examine them under a microscope **Biopsy:** Take a tissue sample for histological examination

Surgical Removal: This depends on the type of tumour and location
